### TPC Sawgrass Stadium Course – Ponte Vedra, Florida



From the initial idea by former PGA TOUR Commissioner Deane R. Beman, the Stadium Course at TPC Sawgrass was built in 1982 to host THE PLAYERS Championship and be the permanent Home of [THE PLAYERS Championship](#). As the first true “Stadium Course,” it was designed to improve the overall on-site fan experience. Finally, the Stadium Course would be a championship-caliber course accessible to all golf fans.

The result is a truly balanced course. Players find a selection of short, medium and long holes within the categories of par-3s, par-4s and par-5s; both right and left doglegs; and a course routing laid out so no two consecutive holes ever play in the same direction. With its signature island green on the par-3, 17th hole being one of the most recognized in golf, this legendary track has captured the imagination of golf fans all over the world and is consistently named among the top golf courses worldwide. While the 17th hole gets a lot of attention, the 18th hole on this golf course – a 462-yard, par 4 guarded by water down the left side, is a formidable finishing hole.

While championship tees stretch the Stadium Course to 7,215 yards, there are three other yardage options to suit your game. The blue tees measure 6,661 yards and the white tees are at 6,103. A blended tee option at 6,402 yards offers a nice compromise. The forward, or ladies’ tees are at 5,109 yards.

The Stadium Course has been honored by multiple golf publications as a top golf destination. *Golf Digest* ranked it 47th among “America’s 100 Greatest Golf Courses for 2015-2016” and ranked the Stadium Course 9th overall among “America’s 100 Greatest Public Golf Courses” in 2015-2016. *Golfweek* ranked the Stadium Course the No. 1 “Best Course You Can Play in the State of Florida.” *We cannot book tee times until we are 14 days out from the date of play.*

## **Long Point Golf Course (Private) – Amelia Island, Florida**



Completed in 1987, Tom Fazio's award-winning design challenges golfers with natural hazards, tight fairways and elevated greens. The rolling fairways wind through three spectacular and distinctive settings: the magnificent marshes, the thick oak and pine forest and the scenic oceanfront dunes. Long Point's character is shaped by natural waste bunkers, large undulating greens and our very distinctive back-to-back oceanfront Par threes. In addition, the golf course demands that the golfers shot carry the water hazard on eight different occasions. Many of these holes leave

the casual observer with breathtaking views of the Amelia River and expansive salt marshes.

Long Point is a par 72 course with a back tee yardage of 6,775 yards. It has been acclaimed as one of the “Top 50 Courses in Florida”, by *Golfweek* and one of the “Best Places to Play” by *Golf Digest*. The Florida Women's Amateur, Men's U.S. Open and U.S. Amateur qualifiers have been held here in the past, in addition to numerous Amelia Island Club events and championships. This course is also the primary course for the Amelia Island Club members. Resort guests may reserve tee times one day in advance, based upon availability.
